LAST NIGHT: Tri-City 3-4-2, Lake Monsters 0-2-0

* Quartet of ValleyCat pitchers 2-hitter with 1 walk & 15 strikeouts
 * Neither team had a hit over the first 4 innings before Tri-City led off 5th with back-to-back singles and walk to load the bases before scoring 1st run of game on an RBI forceout at 2nd base
 * Game stayed 1-0 until bottom of 8th inning when ValleyCats got 2-out, 2-run homer off reliever **Richard Morban** for 3-0 lead
 * Starter **Jack Cushing** issued leadoff walk in 1st then retired next 11 batters before the back-to-back singles and walk in 5th inning
 * **Logan Davidson** had 1st Vermont hit with 2-out single in 8th

BLANKED AGAIN: Vermont has been shutout team-record 13 times this season (previous record 10 shutouts in 2001 and 2012), including back-to-back shutout losses 3 times (6/29-30, 7/3-4, 8/11-12)
 * 10 of the 13 shutout losses by 3 runs or less (5 times 3-0 loss, 3 times 2-0 loss and 2 times 1-0 loss)

WHAT A RELIEF: Jose Mora 11 saves are 2nd in the NYPL, including a save in 7 of last 8 outings (11.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 26 SO) and has struckout 21 of last 29 batters he has faced last 6 outings
 * Mora has 9 saves and a 0.00 ERA (16.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 5 BB, 35 SO) over his last 12 relief appearances and is the 6th Vermont pitcher all-time with 11 or more saves in a season (has 12 career saves)

SEASON FINALE: Lake Monsters have won their last 4 regular-season finales, 8 of last 10 and are 14-11 all-time in finales

MORBAN K'S: Richard Morban 9th in NYPL with 69 strikeouts, tying with **Brent Powers** (2013) for most Vermont K's since 2007

LOGAN'S RUN: Logan Davidson 31 runs last 29 games (3 run in game 5x), tied 4th NYPL with 42 runs (league best 38 since 7/14)

RACINE MVP: Jordan Diaz leads NY-Penn League with 47 RBI 3rd base hits (73), total bases (119), 4th in homers (9), doubles (17)
 * 47 RBI most by Vermont player since 2005 and tied for 5th all-time with **Matt Watson** '99, while 9 HR are tied for the 6th-most

STRIKE THREE: Vermont pitchers have set a new team record with 680 strikeouts this season, breaking old record of 674 in 2012
 * Vermont pitchers also record 367 strikeouts at Centennial Field
 * VT batters also set team record with 729 strikeouts (695 in 2008)

HOMERS: Lake Monsters have 0 homers last 12 games (longest homerless streak of season) after 8 homers previous 5 games
 * VT pitchers 2 HR allowed last 7 games after 25 HR prev 20 games

LOW SCORE: Vermont is just 23-17 when holding its opponent to 3 runs or less (Lake Monsters 7-36 when they score 3 or less)
